The notification to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology has been accepted for the School of International Education, which is scheduled to establish in April 2023.

The School of International Education trains specialists in education, childcare, and psychology with an international perspective "appreciate and learn from diversity" who will open up learning in a new era. In the first year, students focus on the foundation, and in the second year, students choose from a variety of certifications to obtain the qualification they are pursuing for.

The following qualifications are available:

Type 1 teaching certificate for elementary school; type 1 teaching certificate for kindergarten/preschool; teaching certificate for nursery school; licensed psychologist; certified psychologist; IB certificate in teaching and learning PYP; teaching certificate for special needs school
