2. Classes

2a. Occupational Therapy students created autobiography books of the elderlies (Department of Occupational Therapy)

Third year Occupational Therapy students worked on a project to create "only one book" (autobiography) for residents in a nursing home in the Occupational therapy for elderly class on May 27th.

The students were divided into small groups to carry out interviews with the residents using Zoom web conference system. Each group interviewed the elderlies on their work and activity history and the meanings or values associated with the experience, to understand the implications of the experience to their lives.

The objective of this exercise was to understand the importance of listening to the target to improve the communication skill, and also to deepen the understanding of the influence of activities in a life.

The interviews were carried out in a relaxed atmosphere, and both students and the residents were enjoying the interview session. The interviewees were looking forward to receiving their own only-one book in the world.

3. Others

3a. Research Exhibition was held on June 9th and 10th

Seirei Christopher University offers a joint research funding program as a part of the on-campus research funding. The university also offers funding for community projects to promote collaborative projects with anyone involved in healthcare, medical care and social work field to solve local problems by aligning with clinical practitioners in those fields.

A joint research exhibition for nursing, social work and rehabilitation was held on June 9th and 10th on the funding programs for joint research and community projects for the year 2020. The exhibition also included the projects funded for innovative education for the year 2020.
